That means the Alberta product must be grown, produced, handcrafted, processed, or baked by you or an immediate family member or staff. Highest priority is given to "make/bake/grow" (MBG) products. NOTE: Applications from vendors selling commercial, franchise, multi-level, or reseller products WILL NOT be approved for attendance at the Cochrane Farmers' Market.

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Application Review and Approval | Vendor Confirmation

- Applications will be reviewed upon receipt. Please note that vendors are NOT approved on a 'first received' basis. Vendors are selected to ensure each market is balanced across all categories. Vendors will be contacted if additional information is required to complete a review of your application.
- Vendors approved for attendance will receive an email confirmation of application and approved dates.

Checklist for Vendor Profile Submission

2026 Vendor Application | Vendor Profile

- provide all business and contact information – this is required for our records
- provide a complete list of products you will bring to the market as well as information related to their production

** Submit the Vendor Profile form only ONCE for the 2026 Vendor Application process; vendors are responsible for providing updates should the information provided on the form change during the season.*

Food Vendors: submit copies of the following food safety training certification:

- Alberta Food Safety Basics for Farmers' Market OR Food Safety Certification (required)
- Food Handling and/or Mobile Food Permit (if applicable).

Documents will be kept on file for the 2026 season. Provide updates if permit or certificate renewal dates occur during the market season.

All food vendors will have their information forwarded to the AHS Public Health Inspector for approval prior to attending the market.

Alcoholic Beverage Vendors:

- submit a copy of your AGLC Manufacturer's license

Cosmetics Vendors:

- provide documentation confirming product compliance and notification to Health Canada (mandatory - required for approval).

Certificate of Insurance: may be provided after vendor is confirmed for attendance

- Insurance is mandatory for Full-Time vendors
- Strongly recommended for all other vendors, particularly those attending regularly

Product Photos: required for vendor evaluation and approval

- submit a minimum of 3 current product photos. Digital format requested.

Cochrane Farmers' Market | 2026 Vendor Guidelines

- Vendors agree to abide by the market policies, procedures, standards and guidelines

Vendor Applications: Application forms for specific markets should be submitted at the same time as the Vendor Profile. This applies to both returning and new vendors.
